Greetings from Mako Sharks Swim Club Kigali

The health and safety of our athletes and community remain our top priority. In response to concerns regarding the Marburg virus Disease, we are implementing preventive measures to ensure a safe training environment for all.

Health Monitoring

- Daily temperature checks and health screenings for all athletes, coaches, and Parents.
- Anyone displaying symptoms such as **High fever, severe Headaches, Vomiting, Muscle Aches, Diarrhoea or fatigue** will be requested to stay home and consult a healthcare facility or call RBC on 114.

Enhanced Hygiene Practices

- Hand sanitizing station at Pool entry locations; **mandatory use upon entry and exit.**
- Personal equipment (Swimming and non-swimming items) should not be shared.

Physical Distancing

- Athletes, coaches and Parents will maintain of distance on pool deck during training.
- Only one adult per family to escort swimmers to the pool.

Reporting and Isolation

- All Parents should fill contacts form and Club Administration will record all swimmers who joined the practice each training day.
- Any positive Marburg virus case must be reported immediately. We will follow quarantine protocols as per health authorities and communicate necessary updates.
